November 2022 – The SLF is pleased to announce the return of our Genesis Membership Drive as of November 19th, 2022. The goal of this membership drive is to gain 50 new members.

The Genesis Membership Drive offers a host of incentives as checkpoints are reached, including gift memberships, additional Deep Dish readings for the upcoming year, and the first Introduction to Fiction mentor and cohort in time for spring.

Throughout the drive, the SLF will host free panels for prospective members to sample. These panels will cover various aspects of writing, editing, and publishing.

Launched in January 2004 to promote literary quality in speculative fiction, the Speculative Literature Foundation addresses historical inequities in access to literary opportunities for marginalized writers. Our staff and board are committed to representing racial, gender, and class diversity at all levels of our organization.
