The PEN/Phyllis Naylor Grant for Children's and Young Adult Novelists is offered annually to an author of children's or young adult fiction for a novel-in-progress. The award was developed to help writers whose work is of high literary caliber and assist a writer at a crucial moment in their career to complete their novel. The author of the winning manuscript will receive an award of \$5,000. Applications will be accepted through June 1, 2023 at pen.org/pen-phyllis-naylor-grant/.
